

## **City of Galesburg**

### **Regular City Council Meeting**

**Wednesday, June 18, 2025**

**Call to order** at 6:30pm

**Attendance:** Mayor Casey Eggermont, Councilman Don Barcome, and Councilman Jon Johnson were present. Councilman Justin Wika attended later in the meeting, and Councilman Andy Elliott and Auditor Kitty Showers were absent.

**Public Attendance:** Katie Steffl from AE2S

**Additions & Deletions from the agenda:** Motion to approve the agenda with addition of “Mowing” under old business by Barcome, seconded by Johnson. All in favor voted aye, motion carried.

**Minutes:** Motion by Barcome to approve the April 28, 2025 Special Meeting Minutes, the April 29, 2025 Special Meeting Minutes, May 2025 regular meeting minutes, the May 23, 2025 Special Meeting Minutes, and the bills presented, seconded by Johnson. All in favor voted aye, motion carried.

**Correspondence/Open Forum:** None

#### **Old Business:**

**AE2S:** Katie Steffl from AE2S attended the meeting. She reported on the remaining items of the water project, including the gravel to be put on city roads, Naastads putting a gravel pad at the water house, and general conclusion of the project. Steffl requested that a dehumidifier be purchased for the water house. Motion by Barcome to purchase a dehumidifier, seconded by Wika. All in favor voted aye, motion carried. Steffl reported on the lagoon project and relayed there is no official report from Braun yet. Requested additional testing for the liner. Motion by Barcome to complete additional testing at city expense, seconded by Johnson. All in favor voted aye, motion carried.

**Mowing:** Barcome requested to change the policy for mowing lawns in town. Lawns must now be no taller than 8” in height, and residents will be given a 24-hour notice if lawns exceed the limit. Notices will be posted in May of each year to notify residents.

**New Business:** None

**Auditor’s Report:** Motion by Barcome to approve the Auditor’s report, seconded by Johnson. All in favor voted aye, motion carried.

Request from Commissioner Elliott prior to the meeting: Motion to patch the roof from a local handyman at no more than \$400 expense. Motion by Wika to have the roof patched at no more than \$400, seconded by Barcome. All in favor voted aye, motion carried.

**Park Board:** Eggermont relayed the Pork Butt Fundraiser will be held on September 13, 2025.

**Public Works:** Street signs need to be put up, and there was a concern about fuel being siphoned from vehicles.

Barcome and Elliott cleared a culvert and removed part of a sidewalk on Dakota Avenue due to sinking/breaking. The portion of the sidewalk was replaced with a wood-plank bridge.

Barcome requested that all dirt dumping at the lagoon be approved through the entire council. Naastad's requested a location to put dirt from the gravel pad location at the water plant, and Eggermont instructed them to take the small amount of dirt to the current pile at the lagoon prior to this meeting.

**Council Reports:** None.

**Adjourn:** Motion by Wika to adjourn, seconded by Barcome. All in favor voted aye, meeting was adjourned at 7:17pm.
